Butte County Farm Bureau Endorses Dolan for Re-Election

(Oroville, CA) – The Butte County Farm Bureau has announced their endorsement of Supervisor Jane Dolan in her bid for re-election in the 2nd Supervisorial District.

“Agriculture has always been and will remain a priority in Butte County because of the leadership of Jane Dolan. Her advocacy of the Chico Greenline is just one example of many that demonstrate her commitment to support Butte County’s agricultural economy,” said Rocky Donati president of the Butte County Farm Bureau.

The Butte County Farm Bureau, established in 1917, is a non-profit, grassroots organization, supported by 2,000 Butte County families. The Butte County Farm Bureau represents agriculture and rural interests at the local, state and national levels.

“I want to thank the Butte County Farm Bureau for their continued support of me as County Supervisor. I look forward to working with the Farm Bureau over the next four years to keep the Greenline so we can maintain and expand the county's \$580 million agricultural economy and its jobs that go from the fields & orchards to the businesses that provide the equipment and services,” said Supervisor Jane Dolan.

Dolan is seeking re-election in the 2nd District where she has served since 1979 as Supervisor.
